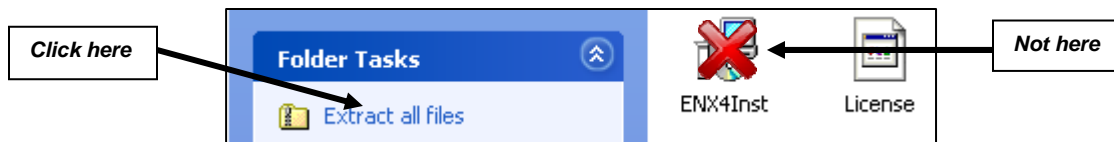


Instructions for downloading EndNote X4

Windows Installation

- Login to your **myWSU** account: <https://mywsu.wichita.edu>
- Under the **Student Tools** heading on the left-hand side of the screen, click on **myTools**
- Under the **General** heading on the left-hand side of the screen, click on **Download EndNote**
- If a **Security Information** window appears, click on **Yes**
- Under **Windows Installation**, check to make sure your computer meets the system requirements by clicking on the link next to **System Requirements**
- Close all other programs you may have open
- Click on the [enx4inst.zip](#) link on the screen
- At the **File Download** screen, click on **Save** and save the file to your **desktop** (you can delete it later)
- When the **Download complete** box appears, click on **Open**
- **IMPORTANT:** You must first click on the **Extract All Files link** on the left side of the screen, or the **Extract** button in the toolbar (this varies depending upon your zip program) -- **do not** click on the **ENX4Inst** icon yet. You'll know if you miss this step because you'll be asked for a "product key"



- Follow the steps in the **Extraction Wizard**, accepting the defaults as you go
- After clicking on the **Finish** button (the final step of the **Extraction Wizard**), **now** you can click on the icon for **EndNote X4** installation – **ENX4Inst**



- If an **Open File – Security Warning** box appears, click on **Run**
- Click through the next series of screens to begin the installation
- At the **Select Installation Type** screen:
 - **Typical** will download **only the top 100** styles and import filters
 - **Custom** will download **all** available styles and import filters, or just **those you select**, and requires a few additional steps in the download process. This guide from the University of Kentucky has some good tips on how to do the **Custom** download (it's for EndNote X3, but still works): <http://wiki.uky.edu/software/Wiki%20Pages/EndNote%20X3%20for%20Windows.aspx>
- The installation may take some time—a large number of files will be downloaded
